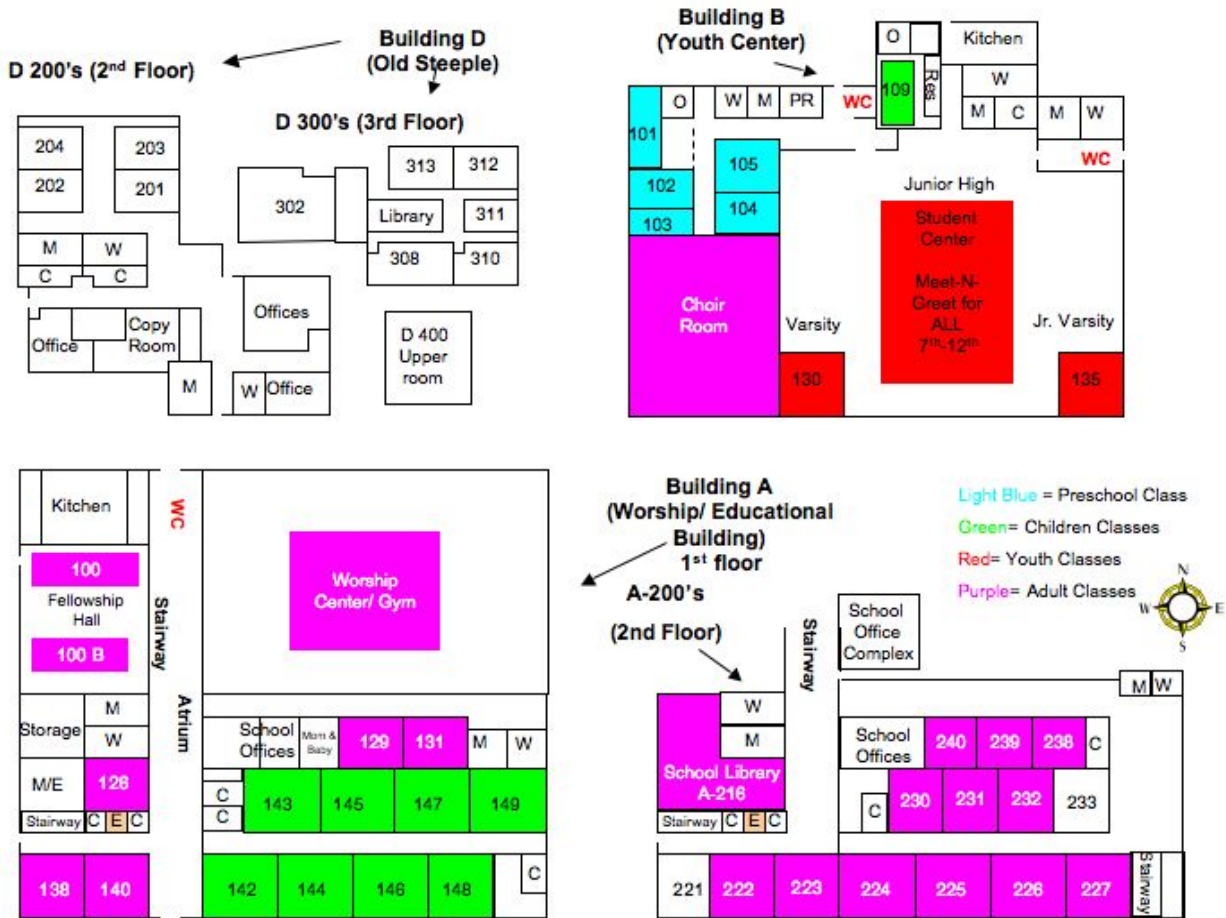

Participants in this class will have opportunities to get involved in other groups and ministries. The class is inspired by Titus 2:3-5 which encourages older women to mentor younger women.

Harmony

A women’s Life Group that provides mature women with a supportive “family” committed to applying the Bible to their stage of life. Whether studying the Bible together on Sundays, or gathering for the Wednesday night meal, this group enjoys adding new women to their fellowship.

Men's Bible Study

This life group is for men who wish to grow closer to the Lord through Bible Study and discussion.

Young Adults

On Your Mark

Teacher: *Jim Daniel* **A-232**
This is a life group for couples either engaged to be married in the coming year or who have been married for less than two years. They will focus on establishing mature relationships with Christ and with one another as they begin lifelong journeys with staying power.

Homebuilders

Teacher: *Chad Owen* **A-225**
Homebuilders is a class that focuses on building stronger marriages by applying biblical principles to the stresses of work, education, finances, and everyday life. Matthew 7:24-25 are key verses for our class.

Foundations

Teacher: *Jeff Simpson* **A-226**
This is a life group whose focus is building a Christ-centered marriage that will last a lifetime. Class members are young married with infants and toddlers.

Median Adults

Family Builders

Teacher: *Delton Bush* **A-227**

Married couples focus on how the Bible applies to real life situations. Life happens! Raising a family, job loss, new town, no friends, first house, family illness, STRESS... See how the Bible applies to everyday life.

Pathfinders

Teacher: *Chad Evans*..... **A-231**

Seeking the path God has planned for us in our lives, our families, our work, and raising our elementary-age children. *Show me your ways O Lord. Teach me your paths. Ps. 25:4*

FOAM (Families On A Mission)

Teacher: *Don Crowley* **A-224**

Mostly parents in their 30s and 40s with children and teenagers supporting each other through Bible study, prayer, fun and fellowshiping together. Teacher encourages interaction for those that feel led, using the LifeWay quarterly curriculum, Family Bible Study.

Age to Age

Teacher: *Mark Roberts* **A-223**

This class is primarily made up of adults ranging in age, from early 30's thru their 40's, with children covering a wide span of ages--sometimes in the same family. The class uses a conversational format as it studies the Bible to help participants experience individual spiritual growth that strengthens marriage and parenting skills while equipping them to reach out to others. The name of the class is based on the scripture found in Hebrews 13:8.

PTL (Preparing to Launch)

Teacher: *Michael Marks* **A-230**

This is a class for the parents of middle school and high school students who are seeking biblical answers to the challenges their children face from peers, school, and culture. During these vital years, marriages also undergo pressures and changes requiring spiritual answers. With these things in mind, we maintain close supporting relationships partnered with sincere searching of God's Word for a life-changing response to the challenges.

Torch Bearers

Teacher: *Joji Varghese* **Choir Room**

Our class consists of adults in approximately the 40 to 50-year-old range in a life stage with high school and college-age students. We have an interactive, conversational learning environment. We have socials every 6-8 weeks which usually includes the entire family. The Torch Bearers' goal is to be the light of the world.

Truth Seekers

Teacher: *Allen Baker* **A-221**

This class of recent or soon-to-be empty nesters is seeking God's Truth in a world of half-truths and Biblical distortions. The goal of the class is to help each member better understand and defend their faith and then to apply it to their daily walk, becoming better ambassadors for Christ. John 14:6 says, "Jesus told him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me!'" (HCSB)

If You Love Me

Teacher: *John Ruddick* **A-222**

This an adult life group fellowshiping and ministering to each other while boldly following Jesus in love to reach the lost for Christ as Lord.

Senior Adults

Heart and Soul

Our class consists of adults in their mid-40s to late 50s and 60s with children that are in college or are married. Acts 4:32, "And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul." Come visit with us as we learn to grow and encourage each other through Bible study, prayer, and fun.

Bible Explorers

Active adults who enjoy book-by-book studies of the Bible using the *Explore the Bible* study plan. The class is open and receptive to new people and new ministry opportunities.

Second Wind

Teacher: *Von Johnston* **A-100 (Fellowship Hall)**
Active adults in their retirement years ready to go and serve where God leads. The members are characterized by an openness to welcome new people, study the Bible, and enjoy the time they spend together.

Joyful Hearts

Teacher: *Allen Kinyon* **A-131**
A class of men and women mostly over the age of 70 committed to Bible study, prayer and support.

How to Join First Baptist Church Centerton

There are three ways to join our church family here at FBC Centerton. All three of these ways are based upon a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord through faith. At the conclusion of our worship services we offer an invitation for anyone to join our church.

1. **You can join by Baptism.** Salvation occurs when a person admits to God that he/she is a sinner and then welcomes Jesus into his/her life as Lord. Following this private, life-changing decision, a person will obey Jesus' command to be baptized. New Testament baptism follows salvation and is by immersion to indicate one's faith in Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. So, a person can join our church through this public demonstration of faith in Jesus.
2. **You can join by Letter.** If you have already been saved and have followed the Lord in believer's baptism, then you can join by a simple transfer of your membership letter from your previous church to First Baptist Centerton. Our office staff will handle the transfer based on your request. We receive members by letter from other churches of "like faith and practice" or simply, these churches "believe and teach the way we believe and teach" on the essentials of the faith. Of course there will be someone ready to help you answer any questions you may have during the invitation.
3. **You can join by Statement.** In the event that your church membership records from your previous church are not available for a transfer, we will accept your word or "statement" of your scriptural baptism from a church of like faith and practice.
